do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, and sold, and by these
presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Isaac Henry, his
executors administrators, and assigns, all the goods, household stuff, imp-
lements, and furniture hereinafter particularly mentioned, that is to say
one clock, one bureau, one chest and three tables, three beds & furniture
one wheat fan, one corn cradle, one loom, two Ploughs, three Harrows,
one Horse, two carts, eight head of cattle, twenty seven Hogs one lance
the growing crop of wheat on the ground, and all the corn on hand
supplied to } Parcels all and singular which said goods and
chattels are now remaining, standing and being in a certain messuage
situate in Chesler's County aforesaid and now in the occupation of the
said Joseph Waddle. To have and to hold all and singular the said
goods household stuff, implements and furniture and other the prem-
ises above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended to be to
the said, Isaac Henry, his executors administrators and assigns forever, and
I the said Joseph Waddle for myself my heirs executors and adminis-
trators all and singular the said goods, household stuff, implements
and furniture and other the premises unto the said Isaac Henry his ex-
ecutors administrators and assigns, against me the said Joseph Waddle
my executors and administrators, and against all and every other
person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and defend
by these presents of all and singular which said goods house-
hold stuff, implements and furniture and other the premises I the
said Joseph Waddle have put the said Isaac Henry in full possession
by delivering to him the said Isaac Henry one horse at the sealing,
