 myself. my executors and administrators. shall and will warrant and for  
 ever defend by these presents to the said Henry Phillips & Reubin C Phillips their  
 Executors. administrators and assigns. the said described property against  
 me my executors and administrators. and against all and every other  
 person or persons. who hereafter claiming the same or any part thereof. In testimony

 ment of said judgement upon which there is now a credit of forty dollars  
 to be entered as of this date and whereas for the purpose of more effectually  
 securing the payment of the said judgement as collateral security thereon
