Twenty head of Cattle. Twenty sheep Two Cows, Ten head of Hogs. one clock. one Bureau. one yk. three Boxes Bedsteads & furniture Two Tables One Chair and all and residue of my household and kitchen furniture & various Implements of every kind whatsoever. By me having the use of said personal property during my natural life lived under my hand the date above written. And the above described property is now assessed to Solomon H. Kirwan as will appear By record Solomon Kirwan

On this 4 day of March 1849 before me the subscriber a Justice of the peace in & for said County appears Solomon Kirwan and acknowledges the above receipt to be his act and deed according to the true intent and meaning thereof and the acts of Assembly in such case made and provided.
