Squell of County State of Maryland and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I the said Littleton Stewart do hereby acknowledge have granted bargain and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Noah J. Squell his executor administrators and assigns the following property to wit three yoke Oxen 1 of each and two Cows all and singular which cattle are now remaining and being on my farm or lot whereon I now live. To have and to hold all and singular the said Oxen Cows to the said Noah J. Squell his executor administrators and assigns forever and I the said Littleton Stewart for myself my heirs executor administrators and assigns against me the said Littleton Stewart unto the said Noah J. Squell his executor administrators and assigns and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 1843
