To have and to hold all and singular the said property and other the premises above bargained and sold or mentioned or intended to be to the said Wm Edmondson his executors, administrators and assigns forever. And the said Robert Harding for myself my heirs, executors and administrators all and singular the said property unto the said Wm Edmondson his executors, administrators ^{& assigns} against me the said Robert Harding my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will forever warrant and defend by these presents - of all and singular which said property and other the premises the said Robert Harding have put the said Wm Edmondson in full possession by delivering unto him the said Wm Edmondson one Pen Knife at the sealing and delivering of these presents in the name of the whole property and premises hereby bargained and sold, or mentioned or intended to be unto him the said Wm Edmondson as aforesaid.
