Bramble of the county and state aforesaid. at and before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge; have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Clement W. Bramble his executor administrator and assigns three Horses. one yoke of oxen, one cart. three cows and two Yearlings thirteen head of sheep and lambs more or less. Seven Shoats. Pigs & Pigs and the crop of wheat. oats & Hay on the Ground. Eight Bushels of corn. one thousand weight of Blades. one carriage and harness. three Beds and Furniture. Twelve chairs. one clock. one safe two Tables. the ballance of the House hold and Kitchen Furniture and all the Farming utensils. all which property is now in my possession. To have and to hold the same described property above bargained and sold to the said Clement W. Bramble his executor administrator and assigns forever. to his and their only proper use and benefits and I the said Jeremiah Bramble for my self my executor and administrator shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said Clement W. Bramble his executor administrator and assigns the said described property against me my executor and administrator and against all and every other person or persons claiming whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof.
