Bramble his executors administrators and assigns, one Sorel Mare three head of Oxen eight Panels of iron one stack of Top Hodder Five hundred weight of Plaster and all the Farming utensils on the Farm Two Beds and Furniture one Loom one Press Two Tables one chest and Trunk and 6 chains all which property is now in my possession to have and to hold the same described property above Bargained and sold to the said Clement H. Bramble his executors administrators and assigns forever to his and their only proper use and benefit and I the said Jeremiah Bramble for my self my executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said Clement H. Bramble his executors administrators and assigns the said described property against me my executors and administrators and against all and every other persons or persons whatsoever claiming the same or any part thereof.
