of Dougherty County in the State of Maryland, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland in the full and just sum of Seven hundred and thirty four dollars and sixty six cents, current money of the United States, to be paid to the said State or its certain attorney, to the which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs, executors and Administrators, jointly and severally firmly by their presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this sixteenth day of June in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty seven.

The Conditions of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Mendal M. Jacobs, appointed Collector of Dougherty County, shall faithfully collect and pay the sum of Three hundred and sixty seven dollars and thirty three cents, current money of the United States, into the Treasury of the State of Maryland, on or before the first day of July in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty eight to and for the use of the State, then the above obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
