in the year of Our Lord eighteen hundred and forty seven.

The Conditions of the above Obligation is such that if the above  
bondsmen Kendal M. Jacobs, appointed Collector of Dorchester County,  
shall faithfully collect and pay the sum of Three hundred and fifty  
seven dollars and thirty three cents, Current Money of the United States,  
into the Treasury of the State of Maryland, on or before the first  
day of July in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty  
eight to and for the use of the state, then the above obligation  
to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
