Marshall, for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, the said Negro Boy Ephraim Addison, an indentured apprentice, unto the said Thomas Holland, his Executors, Administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall & will warrant and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof the said Edward A. Marshall, ^{Seller} and Thomas Holland, Purchaser, have here to set their hands & seals this 17th day of August 1848: And the said Holland is to give said Boy Ephraim freedom due to the amount of Twenty dollars.

 John Wesley Woolford, his Executors, Administrators & assigns, one Negro
 Boy by the name of Henry Mauer, said Henry Mauer being now three years
 of age, and to serve the said John Wesley Woolford, his Executors, adminis-
 trators or assigns, the full time or term of thirty seven years from this
 date, which will be the ninth day of August in the year eighteen hun-
 dred and eighty five, at which time the said Negro Henry Mauer is to be
 free and clear of all servitudes. To have and to hold the said Negro
 Boy Henry Mauer, above bargained & sold to the said John Wesley Woolford,
