Hazzard owes and stands justly indebted to the said James Rea & William Rea in the sum of twenty six dollars, current Money, and to secure the payment thereof is willing to create their presents - Now this Indenture witnesseth, that the said Robert B. Hazzard, for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars, current Money, to him in hand paid by the said James Rea and William Rea, at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Robert B. Hazzard doth hereby acknowledge, and thereof and therefrom doth acquit, release, exonerate and forever discharge the said James Rea & William Rea, their heirs, executors and Administrators, and every of them, by these presents, hath granted, bargained & sold, and by these presents doth grant, bargain & sell, unto the said James Rea & William Rea, their heirs, executors, Administrators & assigns, all and singular the goods, furniture and household stuff hereinafter particularly mentioned and expressed (that is to say) one black Horse, one Waggon & Harness, three Sty Hogs, two Beds, Stools and furniture, one Cupboard and contents, one Brass Clock, one Walnut Table, one pine ditto, three other Pine Tables, one glass case, nine chairs, one pair and Irons, Shovel & Tongs, one Candle stand, one chest, one Trunk, one fancy Case, one pair Pitchers, one looking Glass, frying Pan & Tin pans, one Spider, two Iron pots, one Tea Kettle, one wheel barrow, together with all other household & kitchen Furniture, standing and being on the premises now in the ownership of the said Robert B.
