persons authorized to receive the same, and the duty of his Office, and all  
the other duties of his said Office, by Law imposed, legally, duly and  
faithfully shall discharge, according to Law, and the true intent and  
meaning of the Act of Assembly in such cases made & provided, that  
then the above Obligation to be void and of none effect, or else to remain  
in full force and virtue in Law.

dred and fifty six dollars fifty six and two thirds of a cent, current mo-  
ney, to be paid to the said State, or its certain Attorney, to the which pay-  
ment well and truly to be made & done, we bind ourselves, our heirs, exors-  
tors and Administrators, jointly & severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed  
with our seals and dated this 27<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year of Our Lord  
Eighteen hundred and forty eight. The condition of the above Obli-  
gation is such that if the above bounden John Richardson, as Sheriff,
