Flint, of Charlestown, Jefferson County, Virginia, for divers good causes and considerations me therunto moving, do also in further consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars, current money, to me in hand paid, have released from Slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free, and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my Negro Woman Leah Solly, being of the age of Twenty eight years, and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and her the said Negro Woman Leah Solly, I do declare to be henceforth free, manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me my Executors or administrators forever. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the twenty eighth day of October in the year of Our Lord 1848.
