Mary, aged twenty one years on the twentieth day of April Eighteen
hundred and forty eight, to serve until the twentieth day of
April Eighteen hundred and fifty five, after which time the
said Mary is to be free. And I the said John Mitchell do hereby
warrant and defend the said Negro Girl for the term she has
to serve as above stated against me and my heirs, and against
all persons claiming or to claim the same girl. In Writings
whereof the said John Mitchell, Seller, and Garret McBride,
Purchaser, have hereunto set their hands & seals the 6 day of Novem-
ber 1848.
