In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this twenty Eighth day of December in the Year of Our Lord Eighteen Hundred and forty Eight (1848.)

Be it remembered that on this twenty Eighth day of December in the Year of Our Lord Eighteen Hundred and forty Eight (1848.) personally appeared Robert Parker party to the Within instrument of Writing before me the Subscriber a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland for the said County I acknowledged the Same to be his act and deed for the same purposes therein mentioned and Negroes Arthur named to be hereunto manumitted, and discharged (that is to say Leah from the day of the date hereof and Mary Ann when she shall arrive at the age of Fourteen Years) and discharged from all Service to him or any claiming under him and to be free and manumitted according to the act of Assembly in such Cases made and provided. Know all men by these presents that I Moses Young of Norchester County in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the Sum of Thirty five Dollars Current Money to me in hand by Lewis H. P. Esq. of Norchester County in the said State at and before sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the said Moses Young do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto said Lewis H. P. Esq. his Executor Administrator and Assigns all the following property to wit One Black Buffalo Steer, with white Cocks, One White Steer with Cornish Horns, One Red Steer one pair of Steer with three white spots about his hips, One pair Cart Wheels, One ash tongue Wood rack and leading Chain all and singular which said Goods and Chattels are now in possession of said Moses Young. To Have and To Hold all and singular the said Steer Cart &c. and other the premises above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended so to be to the said Lewis H. P. Esq. his Executor Administrator and Assigns forever. I the said Moses Young for myself my heirs Executor and Administrator all and singular the said Steer Cart &c. and other the premises unto the said Lewis H. P. Esq. his Executor Administrator and Assigns against the said Moses Young my Executor and Administrator and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will want and for ever defend by these presents of all and singular which said Steer Cart &c. and other the premises I the said Moses Young have put the said Lewis H. P. Esq. in full
