Wright his executor Administrator, and assigns one Negro man called Tony aged about forty years and now in my possession, Do Have and Do Sold the same deserted negro above bargained and sold to the said John N. Wright his executor, Administrator and assigns forever to his and their only proper use and benefit and I the said Isaac Wright for myself my executor and administrator, shall and well warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said John N. Wright his Executor Administrator, and assigns the said deserted Negro man against me, my Executor & Administrator, against all & every other person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 10<sup>th</sup> day of February, <sup>February 10<sup>th</sup></sup> Eighteen Hundred and forty nine.
