the County and State aforesaid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof  
I the said Thomas Lee do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold, and by these  
presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said William S. Jackson his executor Adminis-  
trator, and assigns all the goods hereinafter particularly mentioned, that is to say, one yoke of Steers and  
ox Cart, all and singular which said goods are now in the Occupation of the said Thomas  
Lee. To Have and To Hold all and singular the said goods and other the premises above bargained  
and sold or mentioned and intended so to be to the said William S. Jackson, his executor admin-  
istrator, and assigns forever and I the said Thomas Lee for myself my heirs executor and Administrator  
all and singular the said goods and other the premises unto the said William S. Jackson his executor  
administrator and assigns against me the said Thomas Lee my executor and administrator and  
against all and every other person or persons whatsoever. Shall and well warrant and forever defend by  
these presents of all and singular which said goods and other the premises I the said Thomas  
Lee have put the said William S. Jackson in full possession by delivery to him the said William  
S. Jackson ~~in full possession~~ by delivery to him the said ~~William S. Jackson~~ the said goods at  
the sealing and delivery of these presents hereby bargained and sold or mentioned and intended so to be
