I have manumitted set free by these presents do manumit & Set free my Negro girl Called "Rhoda" Ann aged Seven Years & now capable of maintenance & manumission, the said Rhoda Ann being the daughter of my Servant Woman Piscillai the said manumission to take place from this date.
