 bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto her the said Nancy  
 Wing my grand daughter (Charlissa Wenson) to serve the said Nancy Wing until she Charlissa  
 arrives at the age of Eighteen years, and then to be free fully emancipated liberated and discharged  
 from service to the said Nancy Wing and every other person whatever -

 the year of Our Lord Eighteen Hundred and forty nine

 of one Hundred dollars Current money to me in hand paid by Stanley Richardson of Dorchester County  
 and State of Maryland have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain  
 and sell unto the said Stanley Richardson his heirs and assigns negro man Neawan Allen, to serve  
 ten years and five months from the first day of January Eighteen Hundred and forty nine, Slave  
 for term of years as aforesaid and sound in Body and mind, To Have and To Hold the  
 said Negro man Neawan Allen for the term of ten years and five months as aforesaid, from

Paid to the Richardson  
 May 19<sup>th</sup> 1849.
