Richardson and Stanley Richardson, Executors of Nathan Richardson, of Dorchester County and State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars, current money, to us in hand paid by Edward Richardson of Dorchester County and State of Maryland, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the said Edward Richardson, his heirs and assigns, Negro Man Narrow Allen, to serve two years and five months from the first day of January Eighteen hundred & forty nine, slave for term of years as aforesaid, and found in body and mind. To have and to hold the said Negro Man Narrow Allen for the term of two years and five months as aforesaid, from January the first Eighteen hundred & forty nine as above bargained & sold unto the said Edward Richardson, his heirs, executors, Administrators & assigns, against the said Robert N. Richardson and Stanley Richardson, Executors, our heirs, executors and Administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend. In testimony whereof we, Robert N. Richardson & Stanley Richardson & Edward Richardson, have hereunto set our hands & affixed seals this nineteenth day of March Eighteen hundred & forty nine.
