To have and to hold the said Vessel, with all her appertinances unto the said Samuel Corner, his heirs and assigns forever, to his & theirs only use, sole use & use forever, and to and for no other use, intent or purpose. In Witness whereof we have hereunto subscribed our names and affixed our seals this 3^d day of April in the year of Eighteen hundred & forty nine.
