by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said James Thompson
Esquire my Negro Girl named Maria, aged eight years, a servant
for the term of thirty five years from January the first last past, and
sound in body and mind - To have and to hold the said Negro Girl
named Maria for the term of thirty years from January the first Eight-
teen hundred and forty seven, as above bargained and sold, unto the
said James Thompson Esq. his heirs, executors, Administrators and
Assigns, against me the said James Parrott, my heirs, executors &
Administrators, and against all and every other person or persons
shall and will warrant and defend - In Witness whereof
