Coughton of Dorchester County, in the State of Maryland are held and bound unto the State of Maryland in the full and just sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars Current Money of the United States to be paid to the State of Maryland. Which payment well and truly to be made and done We bind Ourselves and every of us Our and every of Our heirs, Executors and Administrators in the whole and for the whole jointly and severally by these presents. Sealed with Our Seals and dated this 20th day of June in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty nine. The Conditions are Such that if the above Bounden William Coughton shall well and faithfully discharge the duties of Treasurer of the Primary Schools of Dorchester County according to Law, then the above Obligation shall be void otherwise it is to be and remain in full force and virtue in Law.
