have resigned the Office of Constable and also recom-
mend, John R. Andrews for the same.

We the Subscribers two Justices of the peace in and for
Dorchester County by virtue of a Supplement to an Act entitled an Act for the establish-
ment, and regulation of the Levy Courts in the several Counties in this State have appointed
John R. Andrews Constable of Election District No 5 in the place of William J. Cowart
who has resigned - Witness our hands and Seal this 17th day July 1829 -
To the Clerk of Dorchester County Court.

I now all men by these presents, that the John R. Andrews, Lewis J. Kern and
Banaman Mills of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland are held and firmly
bound unto the State of Maryland in the full and just sum of Two thousand Dollars
Current Money of the United States to be paid to the said State or its Courts attorney
to the which payment well and truly be made and done We bind ourselves, our heirs executors
and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Sealed with our Seals
and dated this 17th day of July 1829.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden John R. Andrews
shall well and truly execute the Office of Constable in Election District Number Five in
Dorchester County, in all things appertaining thereto and shall well and truly account for
all moneys placed in his hands for Collection, and shall also well and truly pay all
sums of Money received by him or Judgments or otherwise then the above obligation to be
void otherwise of full force and virtue in Law.
