Muse, his heirs & assigns forever, the following property, to wit: one Bed & Bedstead, one Bedstead & bedding for same, one Pine Table, one Cupboard & contents, one Coffee Mill & two Coffee pots, sixteen plates and Tin Bucket, one pair of And Irons, two pots with Hooks, one Oven & Spider, two Tubs & one Bushel Basket, four Hoes & one Grindstone, one Pig, one Bread-bowl, Pinch roller & pin, two stone Jars & two Earthen Jars, one Stone Pitcher & one Earthen Pan, Vegetables in Garden, two Buckets & cooler, one Spinning Wheel. To have & to hold the above mentioned goods & chattels unto the said Doctor William H. Muse, his heirs & assigns forever, to his & their sole use & uses forever, & to and for no other use, intent or purpose whatsoever, against me the said Alexander Stanley & my heirs & against all persons whatever, claiming the same or any part thereof. In testimony whereof I the said Alex Stanley have hereunto subscribed my name & affixed my seal this 2^d day of August in the year Eighteen hundred and forty nine.
