the said title of said LeCompte if it should not be complete. Now these presents Witnesseth
that in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, We the undersigned,
William H. Travers, Isabella Bagby Maria Cooper, and Olivia Travers have & do
hereby convey all their right & title to the said Abby to the said Samuel D. LeCompte.

hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained sold & delivered and by these presents do grant
bargain and sell and do deliver unto the said, One Bay Horse, and a Crop of Corn &
Fodder growing on the ground, one Cupboard, which said property I will warrant and defend
to the said Mary Saddle her executor and administrators and assigns, against me my executor
and administrators and against every other person or persons whomsoever. In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 3rd day of Sept 1849.
