 and a third Cents Current Money of the said State to the payment whereof We hereunto
 bind Ourselves Our ^{heirs} Executors & Administrators jointly and severally ~~firmly~~ by these presents.
 So Witness whereof We have hereunto set Our hands and affixed Our seals this twenty
 seventh day of October in the year of Eighteen hundred and forty nine. -
 The Condition of the above obligation is such that in Case the above bounden Thomas
 H. Nicks shall faithfully perform the Office of Register of Wills for Charles County aforesaid
 then the above obligation to be Void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in Law

 James Cooghegan. } I know all men by these presents, that I James Cooghegan
 of Charles County for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred
 and twenty five Dollars and fifty Cents to me in hand paid by Uriah Todd do grant
 bargain sell unto the said Uriah Todd my negro boy John Comish supposed to be fairly born
 and six months old Slave for life and sound in Body & mind. To have and to hold the said
 negro boy John Comish aforesaid bargained and sold unto the said Uriah Todd his heirs Executors
 Administrators and assigns against me the said James Cooghegan my ^{heirs} Executors & Administrators and
 against all every other person or persons shall and well warrant and save defend. So Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 24th day of October 1849.
