Hooper of Dorchester County in the said State at and before the sealing and delivery
of these presents, the Receipt whereof I the said Thomas Wingate do hereby acknowledge
have granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said
Joseph S. Hooper his Executor administrators or assigns one Grey Horse which said
Horse is now in the possession of the said Thomas Wingate. To have and to hold
all & singular the Grey Horse which I have bargained sold to the said Joseph S.
Hooper his Executor, Administrator or assigns forever and I the said Thomas Wingate
for myself my heirs Executors or administrators and all and singular the said Horse
unto the said Joseph S. Hooper his Executor, Administrator assigns and against
me the said Thomas Wingate my Executors and Administrators and against all and
every other person or persons whatsoever shall and well warrant and forever defend by these
presents of all and singular which said Horse I the said Wingate have put the said
Joseph S. Hooper in full possession by delivering to him the said Joseph S. Hooper the said
Horse at the sealing and delivery of these presents in the name of the whole premises bargained
sold unto him, the said Joseph S. Hooper, as aforesaid. In Witness whereof the said Thomas
Wingate hath hereunto subscribed his name and affixed his seal the 10th day of October
Eighteen Hundred Forty nine.
