to me in hand paid by Abram Cornish of said County, in the said State, at & before the sealing & delivering of these presents, the truth whereof I, the said Solomon Cornish, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained & sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell, unto the said Abram Cornish, his Executors, Administrators & Assigns, all the goods hereinafter particularly mentioned, that is to say, one Yoke Oxen, one Ox Cart, Yoke & Bows, all & singular which said property are now in possession of the said Solomon Cornish. I have and to hold all the said property and other the premises above bargained & sold, or mentioned and intended so to be, to the said Abram Cornish, his Executors, Administrators & Assigns forever. And I, the said Solomon Cornish, for myself, my heirs, executors and Administrators, all and singular the said property and other the premises, unto the said Abram Cornish, his Executors, Administrators & Assigns, against me, the said Solomon Cornish, my Executors and Administrators, and against all & every other person or persons whatsoever, shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents; of all & singular which said property & other the premises, I, the said Solomon Cornish have put the said Abram Cornish in full possession of by delivering to him, the said Abraham Cornish the above property at the sealing & delivering of these presents, in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained & sold, or mentioned & intended so to be, unto him the said Abraham Cornish as aforesaid. Crighton, of the Town of Cambridge, in Dorchester County & State of Maryland, for divers good causes and considerations me therunto moving, as also in further consideration of one dollar, current money, to me in hand paid, have released from
