 } the following Act of Manumission was recorded on
 } the 27th day of December A. D. 1849, to wit:
 } To all whom it may concern, be it known that I,
 Shadrach Mitchell, of the Town of Cambridge in Dorchester County in
 the State of Maryland, for divers good causes & considerations me
 thenceforth moving, have released from Slavery, liberated, manumitted
 and set free my Negro Woman named Emily Wing, aged twenty five years,
 and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and
 her son Jacob Henry Wing, aged five years on the ^{twelfth} ~~ninth~~ day of last
 October, and her daughter George Ann Wing, aged six months on the 25th
 day of the present month; and her the said Negro Woman, named Emily
 Wing, I do declare to be henceforth free, manumitted & discharged
 from all manner of servitude to me, my Executors or Administrators for-
 ever; and the said Negro Children, Jacob Henry Wing and George Ann
 Wing when they arrive at the age of fifteen years, at which time they
 will be able to work & gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance,
 I do declare to be from thenceforth free, manumitted & discharged from
 all manner of service or servitude to me my Executors & Administrators
 forever. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and seal affixed
 this 27th day of December 1849.

 } Bill of Sale was recorded on the 1st day of January 1850.
 } Know all men by these presents that I, William W. Travers,
 } Administrator of Samuel Hunt Jr., of Dorchester County and
 } State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and
 } fifty five dollars, current money, to me in hand paid by Thomas Hughlett of
 } Dorchester County and State of Maryland, have granted, bargained & sold, and by
 } these presents do grant, bargain & sell, unto the said Thomas Hughlett, his heirs
 } and assigns, the following Negro Man named John or Jack, aged about eighteen
 } years, to serve sixteen years from the second day of April next according to the
 } will of Matthias Travers, dec'd. Slave for sixteen years afd., and found in
 } Body & mind. To have and to hold the said Negro Man John or Jack, aged a-
 } bout eighteen years, for the term of sixteen years from the second day of April next,
