

in consideration of two hundred & fifty nine dollars and twenty two cents, current money, to me in hand paid by Hugh Milled, of Dorchester County in the said State, at and before the selling & delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof I, the said Dennis Camper, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the said Hugh Milled, his Executors, Administrators and Assigns, one Man, one Horse, two yoke of Black Oxen, one Cart, Yokes & Bows, two Cows, one Heifer, and one other Steer yearling, thirty head of Hogs, two ploughs, four Axes, and all other Farming utensils included, two Beds, Bedsteads and furniture, and all the other House hold Kitchen furniture including Tables & Chairs, Pots, Ovens, or by whatsoever names or articles there may be, all & singular which said property is now in my possession. To have and to hold all & singular the said property, House hold & Kitchen furniture and the other premises above bargained & sold, or mentioned or intended so to be, to the said Hugh Milled, his Executors, Administrators & Assigns forever - And I, the said Dennis Camper, for myself, my heirs, Executors & Administrators, all & singular the said property, House hold & Kitchen furniture, and other the premises, unto the said Hugh Milled, his Executors, Administrators & Assigns, against me the said Dennis Camper, my Executors, Administrators and Assigns, and against all & every other person or persons whatsoever, shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents.
