 of Dougherty County in the State of Maryland, for and in  
 consideration of the sum of Twenty three dollars, current money, to me in hand  
 paid by Ezekiel Fitzhugh, of the County & State aforesaid, at and before the  
 sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof I, the said Samuel  
 Kirwan, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained & sold, and by  
 these presents do grant, bargain & sell, unto the said Ezekiel Fitzhugh,  
 his Executors, Administrators & Assigns, the goods & Chattels hereinafter  
 particularly mentioned & expressed, that is to say, one Yoke of Oxen called  
 and known by the names of Duke & Diamond, one Ox Cart, Yokes & bow  
 which said goods & Chattels are now remaining in the occupation of  
 the said Samuel Kirwan. I have and to hold all & singular the  
 said goods & Chattels & other the premises above bargained & sold, or  
 mentioned & intended so to be, to the said Ezekiel Fitzhugh, his Executors,  
 Administrators & Assigns, forever: And I the said Samuel Kirwan,  
 for myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators, all & singular the said  
 goods & Chattels, and other the premises, unto the said Ezekiel Fitzhugh, his  
 Executors, Administrators & Assigns, against me, the said Samuel Kirwan,  
 my Executors and Administrators, and against all & every other person or  
 persons whatsoever, shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents;  
 of all & singular which said goods & Chattels I, the said Samuel Kirwan,  
 have put the said Ezekiel Fitzhugh in full possession, by delivering to him,  
 the said Ezekiel Fitzhugh, the said Cart & Oxen, Yokes & bow herein described,  
 at the sealing & delivery of these presents unto him the said Ezekiel  
 Fitzhugh as aforesaid. In witness whereof I, the said Samuel Kirwan,  
 have hereunto set my hand & seal this 16<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year  
 one thousand eight hundred & fifty.
