Know all Men by these presents that of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar, current money, to me in hand paid by Aaron Warfield, free negro, of same County & State aforesaid, have granted, bargained & sold, unto the said Aaron Warfield, free negro, his heirs & assigns, the following Negro, that is to say, Negro Girl named Harriet Ann, aged one year the eighteenth of May Eighteen hundred and forty nine, to serve until the aforesaid Negro Girl is eighteen years old and then to be free. To have and to hold the aforesaid Negro Girl as above bargained and sold, unto the said Aaron Warfield, free negro, his heirs, executors, Administrators and Assigns, against me the said Thomas Hubbard (Senior) my heirs, executors and Administrators and against all & every person or persons whatsoever, shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents.

In testimony whereof we Thomas Hubbard Senior and Aaron Warfield free negro have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this Eighteenth day of February Eighteen hundred & fifty
