Sealed with our seals & dated this 4th day of March in the year Eighteen hundred & fifty.

The condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound William Jackson shall well & faithfully perform the duties imposed upon him, as Clerk of Dorchester County Court, by the Act of Assembly passed at December session Eighteen hundred & forty four, entitled "An Act imposing duties on Promissory Notes, Bills of Exchange, Specialties and other instruments of writing to aid in paying the debts of the State," and shall well & faithfully pay, into the Treasury of this State, all sums of money, which he may receive by virtue thereof, at the periods therein limited for that purpose, then the above Obligation to be void & of none effect, or else to remain in full force and virtue in law.
