This Indenture made this ninth day of March in the year

of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty between Washington Blake of Dorchester County and State of Maryland of the one part, and Elisha Wheatley of the said County and State of the other part. Whereas the said Elisha Wheatley has entered Security for the said Washington Blake to Scumiah Bramble Esq to Secure the payment of the said sum of eighty five Dollars and twenty five Cents and whereas it is the desire of the said Washington Blake to Secure and protect the said Elisha Wheatley from any loss in consequence of said Security - Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Washington Blake for and in consideration of the sum of five Dollars and also of the sum of five Dollars current money to him in hand paid by the said Elisha Wheatley at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and Sell unto the said Elisha Wheatley his Executors, administrators and assigns all and singular the Goods and Chattels and personal property hereinafter particularly mentioned, and to wit that is to say: One Yoke of Oxen, One Ox Cart, One Bed of Furniture, One table, One Chair, four heads of hogs and Six Chairs of wares and I hold all and singular the said goods & Chattels and personal property unto the said Elisha Wheatley his Executors, administrators and assigns to him and their heirs and assigns - Provided always and it is the true intent and meaning of these presents, that if the said Washington Blake do and shall will and lawfully pay or cause to be paid unto the said Scumiah Bramble his Executors administrators and assigns the said full sum of eighty five Dollars and twenty five Cents with the interest thereon whensoever the same shall become due and shall in all respects defend and save harmless the said Elisha Wheatley from any injury or prejudice in consequence of the Security aforesaid, then and in such case these presents and every matter and thing herein contained shall be void and be utterly void to all intents and purposes any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.
