Barnett, of Dorchester County and State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and sixteen dollars, current money, (\$516.00) to me in hand paid by Mrs. Eliza Rauligh, widow of Hooper Rauligh, of the County and State

of Maryland, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained & sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said Eliza Rauligh, her heirs, executors, Administrators & assigns, the following Negroes, that is to say, Negro Girl Martha, aged about fourteen years, and Negro Girl Caroline, aged about ten years, said Martha and Caroline being slaves for life, & found in body & mind. To have and to hold the said Negroes above bargained & sold, or mentioned or intended so to be, to the said Eliza Rauligh, her heirs, executors, Administrators & assigns forever.

In Witness whereof I hereunto subscribe my name and affix my seal this nineteenth day of March in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty.

At the same time personally appears Mrs. Eliza Rauligh, party grantee in the said Bill of Sale, and made Oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that the consideration mentioned in the aforesaid Bill of Sale is true and bona fide as therein set forth, according to the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided.
