Hoyt and Joseph Bradshaw, all of the State of Maryland and Dorchester County, Witnesseth that Whereas the said Henry K. Hoyt owes and stands justly indebted, by judgments of Charles Cochran, a Justice of the Peace, unto Nathaniel Roberts, one Judgment dated 5 day of April 1848 for the sum of forty six dollars & fifteen cents, also on a like judgment in favor of the said Roberts for the sum of fifty five dollars & four cents, bearing date on the same day, & the said Henry K. Hoyt is indebted, by Judgment confessed before said Cochran to one John Bradshaw in the sum of twenty one dollars & six 1/4 cents, dated April 5<sup>th</sup> 1850 - And whereas the said Joseph Bradshaw, for the accommodation of the said Henry K. Hoyt, has superseded the said several judgments and made himself responsible to the plaintiffs in the said judgments for the said sums of money therein mentioned: And whereas the said Henry K. Hoyt is willing & desires to make sure & indemnify the said Joseph Bradshaw for his kind offices and risk by reason of the superseditions above mentioned. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for & in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one hundred & twenty two dollars, current money, in hand paid by the said Joseph Bradshaw, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Henry K. Hoyt hath bargained & sold, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain & sell, to the said Joseph Bradshaw his Horse called Bill which he recently purchased of Dr. Golarborough, and his four wheeled Buggy Wagon & Harness - To have and to hold the said Horse and Buggy Wagon & Harness to the said Joseph Bradshaw & his heirs & assigns forever: Provided always and it is declared to be the true intent & meaning of these presents that if the said Henry K. Hoyt shall will & truly pay and discharge the said judgments, with
