Know all men by these presents that we Levin J. Durnock, Washington A. Smith, William

W. Travers and Fielder G. Jones, of Dorchester County, are held & firmly bound unto the State of Maryland in the full & just sum of three hundred dollars, current money of the United States, to be paid to the said State, or its certain Attorney, to the which payment well & truly to be made & done, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and Administrators, in the whole & for the whole, jointly & severally, firmly by these presents: Sealed with our seals & dated this fifteenth day of April 1850. Whereas the Commissioners of Dorchester County, by virtue of a supplement to the Act entitled an additional supplement to the Act to regulate Ferries, have contracted with the said Levin J. Durnock and Washington A. Smith to keep the Ferry over Slaughter Creek from Taylor's Island to McKins' neck, and agree to allow the said Levin J. Durnock and Washington A. Smith the sum of one hundred & sixty dollars, current money, for the same: Now the Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Levin J. Durnock & Washington A. Smith shall faithfully & diligently keep the said Ferry over Slaughter Creek from Taylor's Island to McKins' neck from day light to day light from the first of November to the first of March, and from an hour before to an hour after day light for the residue of the year, commencing the 10th day of May 1850 and ending twelve months thereafter, and shall keep constantly and in good order a Scow that will safely carry three passengers & their Horses at one trip, with an able bodied & skilful hand to attend the said Ferry, and shall not charge or receive any greater price for services than what is allowed by Law, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise of force & virtue in Law.
