Mills shall faithfully and diligently keep the said Ferry over Fishing Creek from Muckins' neck to Hooper's Island, from day light to day light from the first of November to the first of March, and from an hour before to an hour after day light for the residue of the year, commencing the tenth day of May 1850 and ending twelve months thereafter, and shall keep constantly & in good order a Row that will safely carry three passengers & their horses at one trip, with an able bodied helpful hand to attend the said Ferry, and shall not charge or receive any greater price for Ferriage than what is allowed him by law, then the above Obligations to be void, otherwise of full force & virtue in law.
