 administrators and Assigns forever, to his and theirs only proper use
 and benefit; and I the said John H. Carroll, for myself, my Executors
 and Administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these
 presents to the said Charles W. Brurwood, his Executors, Administra-
 tors and Assigns the said described property against me my Executors and
 Administrators and against all and every other person or persons whom-
 soever claiming the same or any part thereof. In testimony whereof
