Lake, of said County and State, before the sealing & delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Mary M. D. Tubman have granted, bargained and sold, conveyed & transferred, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell, convey and transfer, unto the said Gabriel P. Lake, his heirs & assigns forever, the following Negroes, to wit: one Negro Woman Dary, aged thirty six years - one Negro Girl Louisa, aged three years, and one Negro Boy Charles, aged six weeks, children of said Woman Dary, slaves for life, and now in the possession of the said Gabriel P. Lake. I have and to hold the said above described Negroes unto the said Gabriel P. Lake, his heirs and assigns forever, and to and for no other use, intent or purpose whatsoever, against me the said Mary M. D. Tubman, and my heirs, and against all persons whatsoever, claiming the same or any part thereof.

In testimony whereof the said Mary M. D. Tubman have hereunto subscribed
