Smith, of the County and State aforesaid, - Three feather Beds, 1 set of Stools, 2 tables, 1 looking glass, 3 chests, 1 clock, 3 bedsteads and furniture, earthen ware &c &c - one yoke young Red oxen, two Steifers, 11 head Hogs, 1 hand Mill, 1 Grind Stone, 1 canoe, 1 plough and chains, 2 Aoes. - To Have and to Hold, the above mentioned property, unto him the said Dr Washington A. Smith, his heirs, and assigns, to their own proper use and benefit, and behoof. - Witness my hand and seal this 21<sup>st</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord 1850.
