Be it remembered & it is hereby certified that the following Bill of sale was recorded on the 2^d day of November 1850. I know all men by their parents that I Augustus J. Wheatly of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland, Executor of Jesse Wheatly, late of said County deceased, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty eight dollars, to me in hand paid by Collins Vincent of the County & State aforesaid, at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof I the said Augustus J. Wheatly, Executor of Jesse Wheatly deceased, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the said Collins Vincent, his heirs and assigns, a certain Negro Boy, a slave for life, named Levin, supposed to be about three years old. To have and to hold the said Negro Boy named Levin, above bargained and sold, or mentioned so to be, to the said Collins Vincent, his heirs and assigns forever: And I the said Augustus J. Wheatly, Executor of Jesse Wheatly deceased, for my self my heirs, Executors and Administrators, the said Negro Boy named Levin, a slave unto the said Collins Vincent his heirs and assigns, against me the said Augustus J. Wheatly, Esq. of Jesse Wheatly deceased, my heirs & assigns, shall & will warrant and forever defend by these presents. In Witness my hand & seal this sixteenth day of October in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty
