 which I do hereby acknowledge, I have granted, bargained and sold, and
 by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell to Joseph W. Wheatly, of the
 County and State aforesaid, his heirs and assigns, a certain Negro Girl, a
 slave for life, called Dianna, about two years old. To have &
 to hold the said Negro Girl named Dianna as above bargained and
 sold, or intended so to be, to the said Joseph W. Wheatly, his heirs and
 assigns forever: And I, Augustus J. Wheatly, Exr. of Jesse Wheatly dec'd.
 for myself, my heirs, Executors and assigns, the said Negro Girl named
 Dianna, as above, unto the said Joseph W. Wheatly, his heirs and
 assigns, against against me the said Augustus J. Wheatly, Exr. of
 Jesse Wheatly dec'd., my heirs & assigns, shall and will warrant and
 forever defend by these presents. In Witness my hand and seal this

 and fifty.
