Whalley, his heirs & assigns, the following Negro Girl Sarah, age about four years, purchased of him the said Augustus J. Whalley as Executor of his Father Jesse Whalley, slave for life, and found in body & mind: To have and to hold the said Negro Girl Sarah, age about four years, as above bargained & sold, unto the said Augustus J. Whalley, his heirs, executors, administrators & assigns, against & one the said Thomas Wingate, my heirs, executors & administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall & will warrant & forever defend.
