Know all men by these presents that I, Thomas Wingate, of Dorchester County and State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty four dollars, current money, to me in hand paid by Augustus J. Wheatley, of Dorchester County and State of Maryland, have granted, bargained & sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the said Augustus J. Wheatley, his heirs and assigns, the following Negro Boy named Jacob, aged about six years, purchased of him the said Augustus J. Wheatley as Executor of his Father Jesse Wheatley, slave for life, and found in body and mind: To have and to hold the said Negro Boy, ^{Jacob} aged about six years, as above bargained & sold, unto the said Augustus J. Wheatley, his heirs, executors, Administrators and assigns, against me the said Thomas Wingate, my heirs, executors and Administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall & will warrant & forever defend. In testimony whereof I, Thomas Wingate, have hereunto set my hand and affixed seal this sixth day of November Eighteen hundred & fifty.
