

of the County and State aforesaid, at & before the making & delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof I, the said Caroline Wheatley, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained & sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said Collins Vinson, his Executors, Administrators and Assigns, a negro Woman named Lamy, 22 years old, and slave for life, and her child about three weeks old - To have and to hold the said negro Woman named Lamy and her child above bargained & sold, or mentioned & intended so to be, to the said Collins Vinson, his heirs & Assigns forever: And I, the said Caroline Wheatley, for myself, my heirs, Executors & Administrators, the said negro Girl named Lamy and her child, they being slaves for life, unto the said Collins Vinson, his heirs and Assigns, against me, the said Caroline Wheatley, my Executors & Administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall & will warrant and forever defend by these presents, unto him the said Collins Vinson as aforesaid.
