Know all Men by these presents that I, Thomas Jones of Shen., of Dorchester County & State of Maryland, on account of the natural love and affection which I have for Thomas Jones of Wm. and his wife who is my daughter, and for and in consideration of the said Thomas Jones agreeing to board & clothe me as long as I may live, and for the consideration of the sum of one dollar, current money, to me in hand paid by Thomas Jones of Wm. of the County and State aforesaid, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold & delivered, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell & deliver unto the said Thomas Jones of Wm., a negro woman named Mary, age forty five or thereabouts — A negro woman named Celsy, age twenty two years or thereabouts, and Negro Boy child name John age about five months, Negro Woman Mary, Celsy & her child John slaves for life, which said property I will warrant & defend to the said Thomas Jones of Wm. his executors, administrators & assigns, against me, my executors, administrators, and against every other person or persons whomsoever. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our names and affixed our seals this 30<sup>th</sup> day of November Eighteen hundred & fifty.
