Crawford, Trustee, the Bond or Bonds upon (which the said Craig & Leonard are securities) his executors, administrators and assigns the said sum of eleven hundred and seventy two dollars and six cents, together with interest for the same, at full time as in the within recited premises and condition herein mentioned & appointed for the payment thereof: And the said Hugh Maguire, for himself, his executors and administrators, all and singular the said Negro Slaves, by these presents granted, bargained & sold, and every part thereof, unto the said Samuel Craig & William Leonard, their executors, administrators & assigns, against him the said Hugh Maguire, his executors, administrators, and against all and every other person and persons whatsoever, shall well warrant & forever defend by these presents. In Witness whereof the said Hugh Maguire hath hereunto set his name & affixed his seal the day & date within written.
