of nine hundred dollars, current money, to me in hand paid by Jonah Bayly of
Doughter County & State of Maryland, have granted, bargained & sold, and by
these presents do grant, bargain & sell, unto the said Jonah Bayly, his heirs and
assigns, the following Negroes, to wit: Negro Man Sampson Waters aged about
fifty years, Man Job Waters, aged about forty seven years, Woman Hagar
aged about twenty five years, and her child Maney aged seven years or there-
abouts, Slaves for life, and found in body & mind: To have and to hold the
said Negroes Sampson Waters, Job Waters, Woman Hagar and her child Maney,
as aforesaid, and as above bargained & sold, unto the said Jonah Bayly, his heirs,
executors, Administrators & assigns, against one the said Ann H. Bayly, my heirs,
executors & Administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever,
shall & will warrant & forever defend. In testimony whereof I, Ann H. Bayly,
have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this seventh day of January eighteen
hundred & fifty one.
